today s academic revolution is unprecedented mass higher education has become a worldwide phenomenon with enrollments growing from 100 million to 150 million in just a decade the implications of massification are immense greatly increased participation for a more diverse population including women and many traditionally underrepresented socio economic groups the rise of private higher education diversification of academic institutions and systems and an overall weakening of academic standards at non elite institutions in many countries at the same time higher education is recognized as a key driver of the new knowledge economy because of this research universities at the top of academic systems have become central institutions in contemporary society trends in global higher education analyses these and other key forces shaping higher education today using up to date unesco statistics trends defining higher education are placed in a comparative and international framework patterns of globalization the flow of students and scholars across borders the impact of information technology and other key forces are critically assessed this book is a key resource for understanding the present and future of global higher education

this festschrift is dedicated to ulrich teichler who is celebrating his sixtieth birth day in 2002 ulrich teichler has been a central actor in the development of the field of research on higher education in germany europe and beyond not only has he dedicated his professional career to studying a large number of higher education topics through national and international research projects he was also in the fore front of the efforts to strengthen the structure and profile of higher education re search for example through his involvement in the establishment of the consortium of higher education researchers cher in addition he has contributed to many important scholarly works reflecting on the state of the art and the nature of the field the conventional wisdom is that working in a university or college makes you an expert on higher education consequently while academics like to do research on every possible topic they are in general reluctant to examine their own social insti tution within the european context ulrich teichler is one of the main exceptions to this rule already in his student days he has recognised the unique characteristics of higher education institutions and systems and he understood that special efforts are needed to improve our knowledge on higher education

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this book discusses the situation of taiwanese universities facing a rapidly changing domestic and global environment it examines the social structure drawing on professional perspectives data based and systematic analysis the book fills gaps in the literature of higher education systems in east asia of which taiwan is a

sharing policy the impact of political culture on higher education reform accreditation quality assurance improving teaching and learning promoting technology integration creating inclusive higher education institutions english for academic purposes the relationship between learning style preference and academic disciplines quality work integrated learning student learning in research based doctorates and developing emotional intelligence in higher education students

this book examines several emerging trends in higher education including artificial intelligence and the impact the covid 19 pandemic has had on higher education transformation over the past couple of years all higher education leaders and policy makers are dealing with the aftermath and continuing battle they face regarding higher education within the context of covid 19 ai and the 4ir are also areas that impact every aspect of higher education especially as disciplines are forced to provide credentials and relevance aligned to the workforce and economic needs the chapters provide regional and country case studies from within the asia pacific region

by bringing together leading experts on quality assurance in higher education from seven countries from europe the usa and south africa this volume intends to go several steps further than most publications on quality assurance first it brings together views from micro to macro levels in the multi actor space showing how quality assurance impacts the higher education system throughout second it links quality assurance solidly to issues of regulation translation rather than mechanical implementation and transformation instead of being only focused on quality assurance as a single policy instrument third it uses this broad range of research insights to criticize current practices explaining for instance why sometimes people have difficulty in tracing any concrete effects of all initiatives taken in this area finally the book offers proposals for better focusing quality assurance in the future to address institutional challenges better the general purpose of the book then is to give an engaged academic reflection on how quality assurance is embedded in higher education and in a dynamic way to assess its impacts and potential improvements

in recent decades we have seen the emergence of private higher education as a global reality although there are specific reasons for its appearance in each system there is also a significant degree of commonality in the context and purposes surrounding the rise of private higher education as an important factor in many systems the analysis of private higher education has tended to be focused at the national level often highlighting national peculiarities and variations in this volume the authors move forward by proposing a unifying and coherent but flexible theoretical framework that may be applied in different countries and diverse systems hence the overall goal of this book is to provide a framework for a better understanding of the public private mix of higher education and a set of policy guidelines in dealing with the expansion of private

higher education from a comparative perspective this analytical framework will be applied to four case studies pakistan portugal south korea and uruguay these cases illustrate the diversity of contexts in the development of private higher education though they also highlight important commonalities based on that analysis we present some general recommendations to build a more effective policy framework that takes advantage of the private sector in order to fulfill better the missions of the higher education system

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
